- A. Finance Committee. The Finance Committee has approved a budget of \$1,250 for upcoming WCGOP Picnic, and rate of \$0.07/text for 4,003 text messages to announce WCGOP Picnic to registered WC Republicans who have voted in 3 out of 4, or 4 out of 4 primary elections. The Finance Committee will prepare an annual budget to be presented at the next Executive Committee meeting. Gilliam noted that in the past, Executive Committee members contributed dues of \$50 each. Tuttle questioned the justifiable impact of assessing dues (\$2,100 if assessed). A decision was deferred to the Executive Officers' determination.
- B. Communications Committee. Members were announced. Objectives of increasing notifications to a larger WCGOP audience, utilizing digital media, social media, and text alerts was announced. A full communications plan will be shared at the next Executive Committee meeting.
- C. Events Committee. Plans for the upcoming picnic were relayed. The Events Committee has planned for 500 guests. Burgers and hotdogs will be grilled by volunteers and all condiments will be provided by the WCGOP. Bottled water will be provided. Food trucks with sweet tea and lemonade will also be on site for food purchases. Attendees will be asked to register onsite and names,

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phone numbers, and emails will be requested upon entry. There will be tables for the Young Republicans, Republican Women, Warren County Conservatives, and Voter Registration/Republican Party Registration. All registered Republican senate candidates have been invited to the picnic and allowed 2-3 minutes (max) to address the audience. Security will be onsite and in attendance. A press release and invitation will be sent to local media to attend.

D. Grassroots Committee. The first priority of this 16-member committee is to recruit Precinct Captains for any of the open precincts. The primary strategy will be to recruit within the precincts and if none can be recruited then to find someone in an adjacent precinct. All potential candidates will be contacted by text and invited personally to the WCGOP Picnic.

IX. Elected Officials Updates. Sheriff Hightower explained why property taxes will be delayed until November and that improvements to license renewals that also decrease fraud are in progress. Magistrates Aldridge and Lasley shared updates and upcoming events. Representatives Duvall and Jackson shared their current legislative efforts.
